**Canton Park District
Midget League Rules
(2nd & 3rd Graders)**

1. Games are played on Tuesdays and Thursdays at The Big Creek Park diamond at 5:30 and 6:45 p.m. Monday, Wednesday and Fridays can be used as rain dates. All make up games or Changes must be done through the Park District office, other teams use the field.
 2. First named team is home team, official scorer, provides game ball and keeps both team lineups. A rush sheet can be turned in to the Ledger Office (they have an outside box). Be sure to put players first and last names on the rush sheet otherwise the Ledger will not publish them.
 3. Season will begin with (6) strikes per player. Continuous batting order to be used.
 4. Coaches pitch to their own players from the pitching mound at a distance of 35' (or closer if need be.) 8' circle radius around pitchers mound and 60' bases.
 5. The fielder acting as pitcher will stand next to the coach doing the pitching. The coach does not field the ball and if they catch a ball in self defense the batter will bat again.
 6. No walking, bunting, stealing or barreling allowed.
 7. All players will go to the field on defense with all extras to be in the outfield in fair territory and on the grass. The offense bats (10) players or (3) outs for an inning. 10th batter rule -- no more base runner advancement after ball is returning to pitching circle. When the ball is returning to the pitchers area the base the runners are advancing to is all they get. No base on an overthrow. Advance only to second base on an extra base hit.
 8. A player who throws any equipment in an unsportsmanlike manner will be warned the first time and removed from the game should another warning occur. Coaches need to address this. While batting, if a player throws the bat the first time is a warning and any time after that, batter will be out automatically.
 9. The visiting team will take infield for the first (5) minutes and then home team for the next (5), beginning at 5:15 p.m. or earlier.
 10. The game will last (6) innings. In case of a tie the 7th inning will be the last. There is an hour and (15) minute time limit on games, no new inning will start after that.
 11. All catchers must wear a throat protector on gear, helmet and male catchers should wear a cup. No steel spikes are allowed. Orange and white safety bases will be used. Only medical ID bracelets will be worn. No jewelry permitted.
 12. If a player is injured and can not continue, skip over that player in the batting order. Should that player return to the game he/she goes back in the same place in the original batting order.
 13. Borrow players up to (10). Player must play in the league, bat at the bottom of the batting order and play in the outfield.
 14. (4) different players lead off every game.
 15. Any bat boy or bat girl must wear a batting helmet.
 16. **A mandatory 30 min delay of game will occur if the lightening detection system should sound. Everyone should exit the field, and go to a vehicle. Games called due to lightening can be made up at a later date if both coaches agree. Call the Park District office to reschedule games.**
- **All equipment must be turned in to the park office no later than September.**
